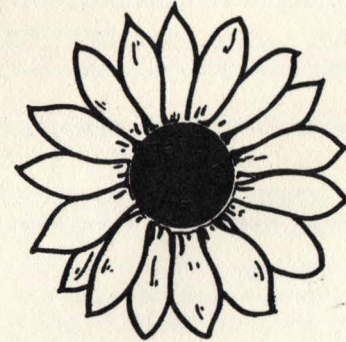

STANDING RULES

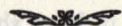


1. The Club year shall extend from the third Friday in Sep-

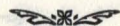

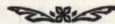
