LEGISLATURE.

The Legislative Assembly is composed of a Council and House of Representatives, and convenes annually, at Great Salt Lake City, on the second Monday in December.

The Council is composed of thirteen members, who are elected for two years. The House of Representatives is composed of twenty-six members, elected annually.
