**BENTON COUNTY.** Boundaries—North by Tillamook and Polk, east by the Willamette River, south by Lane, and west by the Pacific Ocean. Area of the County, 1150 square miles. Population, estimated, 3,600. The eastern portion of this county, lying adjacent to the Willamette and its tributaries, contains large tracts of agricultural and grazing land. The western portion, embracing the district of Yaquina Bay, is attracting considerable attention as an agricultural and commercial point. The stock raised in this county is superior, and the yield of wheat and oats for the year 1864 exceeded 210,000 bushels. Value of real and personal property, 1865, \$1,400,000. County seat, Corvallis.
