San Juan Island. in the Gulf of Georgia, bounded on the east by Rosario Straits, and on the west by the Canal de Haro. This island created a considerable controversy, a few years since, between the British and American Governments, concerning the boundaries of their respective territories, which came near ending in a war between the two nations. It is now occupied jointly, the British having a fort on one end of the island, and the Americans one near the town of San Juan. This island is exceedingly fertile, and well adapted for grazing and agricultural purposes, and contains an area of 40 square miles.
