ALTURAS COUNTY. Boundaries—North and east by Montana Territory, south by Oneida and Owyhee, and west by Boise. This county has a mountainous surface, with an abundance of water for milling and mining purposes. A large number of rich gold and silver claims have been developed, and there are now (November, 1866) engaged in crushing the ore twelve quartz mills, with an aggregate of nearly 150 stamps. Placer diggings exist on Feather River, Yuba River, and Grouse Creek. County seat, Rocky Bar.
