BOISE COUNTY. Boundaries—North by Idaho, east by Alturas, south by Ada, and west by Ada. This county is the richest and most populous in Idaho, and includes Boise Basin, which is said to be the largest and most productive placer mining region in the Territory. There are also many rich and valuable quartz lodes, and there are at present (October, 1866) nine quartz mills, with an aggregate of 100 stamps, profitably engaged in crushing ore therefrom. An abundance of wood and water exists, for milling and mining purposes. The climate is mild and serene during the summer and fall, cold in the winter, but generally healthy throughout the year. Warm springs exist within a few miles of Idaho City. The towns of Idaho City, Placerville, Centerville, and Pioneer City, with an aggregate of over 10,000 inhabitants, are included within the limits of this county. County seat, Idaho City.
