**JUAB COUNTY.** Boundaries—North by Tooele and Utah, east by Utah and San Pete, south by San Pete and Millard, and west by Tooele and San Pete. This county occupies a central position in the Territory. It has a mountainous surface, and, for the most part, is unproductive. The Wasatch Mountains form the eastern border, and in the northern part is Mount Nebo, 12,000 feet high. The number of acres cultivated in 1865 was 1,780, of which 1,000 were in wheat. Number of mills: saw, one; grist, two. County seat, Nephi.

**KANE COUNTY.** Boundaries—North by Iron, east by Colorado Territory, south by Arizona Territory, and west by Washington. "In consequence of Indian hostilities, all the settlements of this county have been vacated, except two, and everything is, therefore, in an unsettled condition. There are no merchants, manufacturers, lawyers, or physicians. It is a distant county of the Territory, with no thoroughfare through it, except into an Indian country. It is rugged and broken, and its soil sterile." County seat, Grafton. (No returns of county officers received.)
