Yale, P O. This is a small town at the head of steam navigation, on the Fraser, 105 miles above New Westminster, and enjoys a flourishing business in the transmission of goods to the Cariboo mines. Two steamers run twice a week between the two towns. The freighting business to the mines, from Yale, gives the best idea of the importance of British Columbia, employing, as it does, over 3,000 animals. Barnard's stages leave this town for the Cariboo country, and an opposition line was started, last year, by Mr. Davis.
