The subsequent night, the following ordinance was passed :

*An Ordinance finally settling, adjusting and compromising the question of the Water Front :*

The Council of the City of Oakland do ordain as follows :

SECTION 1. It appearing to the satisfaction of the Council that all the terms and conditions of a certain ordinance, heretofore passed, entitled " An Ordinance for the settlement of controversies and disputes, concerning the Water Front of the City of Oakland, the franchises thereof, and other matters relating thereto," have been fully satisfied and complied with by Horace W. Carpentier and his assigns, all the ordinances and deeds therein mentioned and described, are hereby finally ratified and confirmed, and all disputes, controversies, claims, demands and causes of action heretofore existing between the City of Oakland, on the one part, and Horace W. Carpentier and his assigns, of the other part, relating to the force and validity of the said ordinances and deed, are hereby abandoned and released by the said City of Oakland to the said Carpentier and his assigns, *provided*, that nothing herein contained shall release the right of the said City of Oakland to the reversion of the property, franchises and rights released, as provided in the contract be-
