The City is divided into Special Police Districts as follows.
 Number one is bounded by Franklin, South Front, Washington and Fourteenth streets.
 Number two is bounded by Franklin, South Front, East Front and Fourteenth sts.
 Number three is bounded by Washington, South Front, Market and Fourteenth streets.
 Number four is bounded by Market, Union, West Fourteenth and South Front sts.
 Number five is bounded by Union, Peralta, West Fourteenth and South Front streets.
 Number six is bounded by Peralta, West Fourteenth sts. and the waters of the Bay.
 Number seven is bounded by Fourteenth and Market streets, and the charter line.
 Number eight is bounded by Market, West Fourteenth, the charter line and the waters of the Bay.
