Hollister, San Benito Co, P O and county

seat 94 miles southeast of San Francisco. Until recently Hollister and San Benito county formed the eastern side of Monterey county, but the Gabilan Mountains formed such a natural barrier between the east and the west side that the formation of a new county became a necessity, and since May, 1874, San Benito county has had a separate organization, with Hollister as the county seat. In 1863 an association of fifty members purchased the Hollister Rancho, consisting of upwards of twenty thousand acres, twelve thousand of which comprised the head of the great Valley of Santa Clara, and here was the town of Hollister built. The location is pleasant, the surrounding country fertile, and well adapted for cultivation and grazing, and the

scenery is attractive. The town commands a large trade, having the country for a hundred miles south tributary to it, comprising the quicksilver mines of New Idria, Panoche, and Pleacho, in the Monte Diablo Range, and the Valley of San Benito, which separates that range from the Gabilan Mountains. A branch of the Southern Pacific Railroad has been extended to Hollister, and a few miles south to Tres Pinos, adding to its advantages. Its progress since its commencement has been very rapid and its future promises to be equal to its past. Two newspapers, the *Enterprise* and *Advance*, are published weekly. The town officers consist of five trustees, a marshal, treasurer, clerk and assessor.
