WARDS AND ELECTION DISTRICTS.

FIRST WARD.—That part of the City of Oakland lying west of Adeline Street.

SECOND WARD.—North of Twentieth and Delger streets, and east of Adeline Street.

THIRD WARD.—East of Adeline Street, south of Twentieth and Delger streets, west of Broadway Street, and north of Tenth Street.

FOURTH WARD.—East of Adeline Street, west of Broadway Street, south of Tenth Street, and north of the southerly charter line.

FIFTH WARD.—East of Broadway Street, south of Twentieth and Delger streets, north of Tenth Street, and west of Oakland and Brooklyn township lines.

SIXTH WARD.—East of Broadway Street and south of Tenth street.

SEVENTH WARD.—East Oakland.

Academy of Music, south side of Sixth between Washington and Broadway.

Dietz Opera House, north side of Twelfth between Webster and Harrison.

Germania Hall, east side of Webster between Sixth and Seventh.

PUBLIC GARDENS, PARKS, ETC.

Grand Central Park, east side of Seventh Avenue between East Seventh and East Tenth.

Humboldt Park, junction Telegraph and Humboldt avenues, Temescal.

Oakland Trotting Park, between San Pablo Avenue and Berkeley Railroad, 2 miles north of City Hall.

Shell Mound Park, on the Berkeley Railroad, 2 miles north of Oakland Point.

Zimmerman's Gardens, northeast corner of Second and Harrison.

City, foot of Webster.

Larue's, foot of Fourteenth Avenue.

Oakland Ferry, foot of Seventh, Oakland Point.

Washington Street, foot of Washington.
