Embraces 127 acres, four miles from San Leandro. It is designed for the care of the sick poor and for the aged and infirm. C. S. Coleman and A. S. Du Bois, Physicians. J. F. Burdick, Steward. The number of patients remaining on January 1, 1878, was 87. The number of admissions in 1878 was 362; 311 were discharged, and there were 46 deaths. The number of patients remaining on January 1, 1879, was 92. The total current expenses for the year were \$21,368.37.
