**Free Library and Central Reading Rooms of Oakland.**

North side of Fourteenth Street, between Washington and Clay Streets. The association has been formed to provide a free reading-room to the public. Here will be found newspapers and periodicals aggregating over one hundred in number. The library contains nearly 10,000 volumes. Branches of this institution have been established at 1704 Seventh Street, West Oakland, and at 622 East Central Avenue, East Oakland. Open daily, Sundays and holidays excepted, from 9 A. M. to 8 P. M. Reading-room open on Sundays and holidays, from 9 A. M. to 9 P. M. Wilbur Walker, President; E. M. Long, Secretary and Treasurer; Miss Ina D. Coolbrith, Librarian; Henry F. **Odd Fellows' Library.**

The present number of volumes in the library is a little over 4,200; several hundred volumes have recently been added to the collection. During 1880, 19,623 volumes were taken out for persual. The library is sustained by Oakland, University, and Fountain Lodges, of Oakland, and Porter Lodge, of West Oakland; each lodge contributing fifty cents per quarter for each member of the lodge in good standing.
