# Pig Tail Staples on Your Stucco Work

THE PIG TAIL STAPLE is a scientifically designed device which offers an improved and simplified method of fastening the reinforcement for stucco work to its supporting frame. Its peculiar and original design is such that it acts:

FIRST—As a spacer for the reinforcement, keeping same where it scientifically should be, at a uniform distance from the sheathing. This insures uniformly equalized stresses in both the reinforcement and the plaster, giving an even thickness of plaster, the life of which is materially increased due to its compact and homogeneous nature, thereby reducing the cost of upkeep and repairs.

SECOND—As a fastener for the reinforcement it cannot be pulled out like an ordinary nail or staple. Though driven like a nail, the design is such that it must be unscrewed to be removed.

THIRD—Driving with a screw motion, the PIG TAIL engages the reinforcement, which rides up and along the TAIL to the proper height, where it is held in place; the twisting motion then locks, tightens and stretches the reinforcement, insuring a well stretched job.

FOURTH—The short arm, or the end of the PIG TAIL, holds the building paper tight against the sheathing.
