In 1928 graduates of the A-to-Zed School entered 21 different universities and colleges. Sixty-six A-to-Zed graduates were enrolled in the University of California during the past year.

The A-to-Zed School also has a special department devoted to the preparing of students for the College Board Examinations. Seventy-five per cent of the A-to-Zed students who took these examinations in 1928 were successful and entered the University in August.
