The land there can be acquired from the Government by citizens in limited quantities only (40 to 320 acres to each man or woman, married or single) under the Desert Act, without residence, and all the requirements of which can be attended to for you by us in your absence. We want to get customers for the water we will have to sell—Uncle Sam won't buy it to irrigate with—so we will help you to a few choice acres.

It's a beautiful valley, with level, rich land, and in its center a fresh water lake a hundred square miles in area. A railroad runs through it, and the new one projected to Salt Lake will cross it.
