MARK HOPKINS INSTITUTE OF ART, CALIFORNIA AND MASON STREETS.

The San Francisco Art Association was organized March 25th, 1871. It has for its objects "the promotion of painting, sculpture and fine arts akin thereto; the diffusion of a cultivated taste for art in the community at large, and the establishment of an Academy or School of Design." On July 30th, 1889, the Association was incorporated, while in February, 1893, it became affiliated with the University of California. On this occasion Mr. Edward F. Searles deeded to the Regents of the University of California for the use of the Association, the magnificent property now known as the Mark Hopkins Institute of Art. Mr. Searles has recently added to his gift a picture gallery of imposing proportions, making this institution with its extensive collection of admirable paintings and statuary one of the most notable art centers of the West. The membership, which is unlimited, numbers about 600. The School of Design is managed by a committee of the Association. The painting, sculpture, drawing and other class rooms occupy a separate building in the picturesque grounds of the institute. The attendance averages 150 pupils.
