

- IDORA PARK**—Oakland. Key Route from S. ave. cars from Broadway, Oakland.
- LAFAYETTE SQUARE HILL**—Fine residential district. Jackson or Sacramento st cars.
- LAKE TAHOE**—Southern Pacific to Truckee.
- LAND'S END**—Bet Baker's Beach and Cliff House. Sutter st cars No. 1.
- LATIN QUARTER**—Vicinity Broadway and Columbus ave. Kearny or Union cars.
- LIFE SAVING SERVICE**—On Ocean boulev. near Cliff House. Ellis, Park and Ocean cars No. 20.
- LIME POINT**—Opp. Fort Point.
- LOTTA'S FOUNTAIN**—Geary, Market and Kearny streets. Erected in 1875 by Miss Lotta Crabtree. Mme. Tetrazzini gave an open air concert Christmas eve, 1909, at this point. All Market, Kearny or Geary cars.
- LURLINE SALT WATER BATHS**—Bush and Larkin, Sutter or Polk and Larkin cars
- MARE ISLAND**—Thirty miles from S. F. naval headquarters. Monticella S. S. Co., Clay street wharf.
- MILE ROCK LIGHTHOUSE**—Near Land's End. Sutter st cars No. 1.
- MINING BUREAU**—Ferry bldg. All Market st cars. Mission, Howard or Folsom (direct), California (1 blk).
- MINT (U. S.)**—5th and Mission. Market, Powell or Mission.
- MISSION DOLORES**—16th and Dolores. Founded 1776. Fillmore and 16th st cars (direct). All intersecting lines except California transfer.
- MT. TAMALPAIS AND MUIR WOODS**—Via Sausalito ferry, foot Market street. Two hours' ride. Round trip, \$1.90.
- NAVAL TRAINING STATION**—Goat Island. Gov. boats leave Clay st wharf. Permit necessary.
- NEW CITY HALL**—S S Market, bet 8th and 9th. Haight, Valencia, Market or Hayes st cars.
- NOB HILL**—That portion of city near Fairmont. Famous residences of multi-millionaires destroyed by fire, 1906.
- OAKLAND, ALAMEDA, BERKELEY AND PIEDMONT**—Key Route or Southern Pacific at Ferry Depot, foot Market. All lines direct or transfer.
- PALACE HOTEL**—Market and New Montgomery sts. The interior court is magnificent. All Market st cars (direct). Geary, Kearny, Mission, or Sutter, (1 blk).
- PORTSMOUTH SQUARE**—Kearny, between Clay and Washington. Kearny or Sacramento cars.
- POSTOFFICE**—7th and Mission. Cost \$5,000,000. All Market (except Eddy or Sutter) and Mission cars.
- PRESIDIO RESERVATION**—Gov. reservation. 1590 acres. Union st cars. Fillmore or Polk and Larkin and lines transferring to same re-issue to Union cars (direct).
- PANAMA-PACIFIC International Exposition**, Grounds from Fort Mason to Presidio, Lombard to S. F. Bay. The completion of the Panama Canal, in 1915, is distinctly a Pacific Ocean event. It joins the Pacific with the Atlantic and opens the Pacific to the commerce of the world. San Francisco, the largest American port on the Pacific, is logically and sensibly the Exposition city. San Francisco's Exposition will be the whole West's Exposition. San Francisco has assured \$17,500,000 for the celebration—her citizens raised \$4,089,000 in two hours. San Francisco—the new city—has the climate, the people, the enthusiasm, the accommodations, the location. San Francisco, the West and the entire Nation should celebrate the event that makes the two oceans one. In San Francisco's superb harbor the navies of all the world may maneuver and at her Exposition the people of all the world may learn civilization's newest lessons and enjoy themselves in climatic comfort. - RUSSIAN HILL**—Bet Mason and Hyde on Broadway to Lombard. Great many residences saved from fire. California & Hyde st cars.
- SEAL ROCKS AND CLIFF**—One of the principal points of interest. Sutter st cars.
- STANFORD UNIVERSITY**—Palo Alto, Cal. Southern Pacific at 3rd and Townsend to Palo Alto. Time, about 1½ hours.
- STATUARY**—Outside Golden Gate Park; Cal. Volunteers, Spanish-American War, Market and Van Ness av. Dewey Monument, Union Sq., Donahue, Market and Battery, Lick, Marshall Sq., opp 8th. Native Sons, Mason, Taylor and Market.
- ST. FRANCIS HOTEL**—Powell and Geary sts, opp. Union Square Park. Geary or Powell st cars. Market cars transfer to Powell.
- SUTRO BATHS AND HEIGHTS**—Baths largest in world. Sutter st cars.
- TELEGRAPH HILL**—Bet Sansome and Grant av. and N of Broadway. Kearny st cars. Market, Sutter or Mission transfer.
- TRANSPORT SERVICE**—Fort Mason. Gov. permit. Folsom or Harrison st cars (direct). Market (3 blks).
- UNION IRON WORKS**—Potrero, 18th and Kentucky, 3d and Kearny cars. Transfer to Kentucky or 8th and 18th cars.
- UNION SQUARE AND DEWEY MONUMENT**—Geary, Post, Stockton and Powell. Market cars, transfer to Powell, Geary or Post cars (direct). Hyde (1 blk).
- UNIVERSITY OF CALIFORNIA**—Berkeley. Southern Pacific or Key Route to Berkeley. Time, about 1 hour.
- WEATHER BUREAU**—Merchants' Exchange bldg. California bet Sansome and Montgomery. California, Montgomery or Sansome st cars (direct). Kearny or Sacramento (1 blk).
