SANTA CRUZ,

Via Saratoga, Congress Springs, Ocean View, San Francisco Saw Mills, San Lorenzo Flume and Transportation Co's Mills, Boulder Creek and Felton.

This delightful Route, for a distance of TWENTY-FIVE Miles, passes through beautiful Mountain Scenery, and magnificent Redwood Forests, which shade the Road, making it one of the pleasantest Drives in the State.

For FOURTEEN Miles, the Road follows the San Lorenzo V Flume, and passes one Paper Mill, ten Saw Mills, one Fuse Factory, three Lime Kilns and the California Powder Co's Works. It also passes Boulder, Bear, Newell, Love, Fall and Sayante Creeks, whose waters are well stocked with Mountain Trout, the forests abounding in game of all kinds.

From "Ocean View" can be distinctly seen the whole of Santa Clara Valley, Pescadero, Page's Mills, San Francisco Bay, the Pacific Ocean, Santa Cruz, and, in a clear day, the far distant city of San Francisco.

The Stage leaves the CAMERON HOUSE, Santa Clara, on Mondays, Wednesdays and Fridays, at 7 A. M.
