Directions.

Take two-thirds the quantity that you would of Eastern Starch, and pour on COLD Water sufficient to dissolve it: then pour on HOT Water, stirring until it boils and becomes clear: then reduce to a liquid state, dip the Linen in, and wring it out. Iron when damp. This will leave an ELASTIC STIFFNESS and a FINE SATIN GLOSS.
