THIS town built at the base, and on the slopes of the steep hills which line the western shore of Richardson's Bay, extends in its total length a distance of about 2 miles. It is distant from San Francisco 6 miles, with which place ferry connection is had, four trips being made daily. It is one of the principal termini of the North Pacific Coast R. R. the company having built
