

its location, it is the center of large freight shipments, quicksilver and sulphur from the Lake County mines being hauled to this point for shipment by rail. The famous Petrified Forests are found about 5 miles from the town, while the Geysers are 26 miles distant. Stage lines radiate from Calistoga to all points in Lake County, in one direction, and in others to Knight's Landing, the Geysers, and Santa Rosa. The town sustains a good newspaper in the *Calistogan* (weekly), has a good town hall, three churches, and its full complement of business houses. In its hotel accommodations it ranks exceptionally well for a town of its size, the Magnolia and Cosmopolitan being especially worthy of patronage.
