THIS town, in the extreme northern part of the county, thirty-two miles

from Santa Rosa, is the present northern terminus of the San Francisco and North Pacific Railroad. Shipments from Mendocino and a great part of Lake County concentrate here, making the point one of great business activity. Daily stage lines leave here for Eureka, and various points in Lake County. The export of wool reaches fully 1,500,000 pounds annually, and hops 500,000 pounds. The latter product being cultivated with great success in the Russian River Valley.

The town has post, express, and telegraph offices; sustains a wide-awake newspaper in the "Pacific Sentinel," weekly; has many important business establishments, and is well provided in the way of hotel accommodations. The Cloverdale Union, and American being all well worthy of patronage. Population about 1,000.
