MAYOR OF THE CITY AND COUNTY.—HENRY P. COON, *ex officio* President of the Board of Supervisors. Term expires July 1, 1865. Salary, \$3,000 per annum.

CLERK.—CHARLES L. WIGGIN, appointed by the Mayor. Salary, \$1,500 per annum.

## BOARD OF SUPERVISORS—1863-'64.

Term of office two years—one-half elected annually. Term expires first Monday of July. Weekly meetings every Monday evening. Quarterly meetings first Monday in January, April, July, and October. Special meetings at the discretion of the President.

*President.*—HENRY P. COON, (Term expires July 1, 1865). Salary, \$3,000 per annum.

*Clerk.*—JAMES W. BINGHAM, appointed by the Board. Salary, \$2,400 per annum.

*Sergeant-at-Arms.*—B. S. Blitz. Salary, \$600 per annum.

## CITY AND COUNTY OFFICERS—1863-'64.

*County Judge.*—HON. M. C. BLAKE; term expires January, 1864; salary, \$5,000 per annum. *Associate Justices of the Court of Sessions.*—Martin W. Lamb and George Fisher; salary, \$5 per day when acting, not to exceed \$600 per annum each.

\* A special election for Justices of the Supreme Court, District Judges, County Judges, and all other judicial officers, required by law, and a State Superintendent of Public Instruction, takes place on the third Wednesday in October, 1863, and every two years thereafter.—*Act March 21, 1863.*
