MAYOR OF THE CITY AND COUNTY—THOMAS H. SELBY, *ex officio* President of the Board of Supervisors. Term expires December, 1871. Salary, \$3,000 per annum.

CLERK—WILLIAM V. WELLS, appointed by the Mayor. Salary, \$1,800 per annum.

BOARD OF SUPERVISORS—1870-71.

Term of office two years—one-half elected annually. Salary \$100 per month. Terms expire first Monday in December. Weekly meetings each Monday evening. Quarterly meetings first Monday in January, April, July, and October. Special meetings at the discretion of the President.

President—THOMAS H. SELBY (Term expires December, 1871). Salary, \$3,000 per annum.

Attorney City and County—WELLINGTON C. BURNETT (Term expires December, 1872). Salary, \$5,000 per annum.

Clerk—JOHN A. RUSSELL, appointed by the Board. Salary, \$2,400 per annum.

Deputy Clerk—THOMAS H. REYNOLDS. Salary, \$1,500 per annum.

Sergeant-at-Arms—HENRY J. KEEFE. Salary, \$600 per annum.

* The State Election takes place biennially, on the first Wednesday of September except the year of the Presidential Election, when it takes place on the same day. The Judicial election for Justices of the Supreme Court, District Judges, County Judges, and all other judicial officers, required by law, and a State Superintendent of Public Instruction, takes place on the third Wednesday in October, 1871, and every two years thereafter.
