

The amount absolutely collected on is much less than the aggregate valuations for the last two years. For the year 1868-9, the delinquent list amounted to \$429,709, on an assessed value of \$13,500,000, in 1869-70 to \$556,320, on \$18,062,340, and in 1870-71 to \$170,603 on \$5,996,584. The small amount of delinquent taxes of 1870-71, compared with the two previous years, may be accounted for by the fact that moneys loaned on mortgages which amounted in the years named to an assessed aggregate of about \$30,000,000, have been declared exempt from taxation.

The amount expended by the Department of Streets during the year 1870-71 is \$843,415 against \$1,248,130 in 1869-70, which, added to the sum included in the above table, \$2,819,617, makes the total expenditures of the Municipal Government for 1870-71, \$3,663,032.

The special Fee Fund for 1870-71 aggregated \$153,685, of which the Recorder paid \$44,975, the County Clerk \$41,028, the Sheriff \$20,552, the Tax Collector \$19,244, and the Clerk of the Justice Court \$9,867.

For the year ending June 30, 1871, the following amounts were paid in support of the different departments of the Municipal Government: Salaries, \$353,366; Police Department, \$157,218; Fire Department, \$193,460; School Department, \$638,001; Street Lights, \$200,583; Hospital, \$108,621; Alms House, \$75,571; Industrial School, \$36,906; Redemption of Bonds, \$177,045; Interest on Debt, \$225,462.
