### STATE CONGRESSIONAL.

*First District.*—The City and County of San Francisco.

*Second District.*—The counties of Contra Costa, Alameda, San Joaquin, Calaveras, Amador, El Dorado, Sacramento, Placer, Nevada, Alpine and Tuolumne.

*Third District.*—The counties of Marin, Sonoma, Napa, Lake, Solano, Yolo, Sutter, Yuba, Sierra, Butte, Plumas, Lassen, Tehama, Colusa, Mendocino, Humboldt, Trinity, Shasta, Siskiyou, Klamath and Del Norte.

*Fourth District.*—San Diego, Los Angeles, San Bernardino, Santa Barbara, San Luis Obispo, Tulare, Monterey, Fresno, Kern, Merced, Mariposa, Stanislaus, Santa Clara, Santa Cruz, San Mateo, Mono and Inyo.

At the election September, 1874, and at the election every two years thereafter, there shall be elected from each district one Representative to the Congress of the United States.

### JUDICIAL.

*Third District.*—Comprises the Fifth ward of the City of San Francisco and the County of Alameda.

*Fourth District.*—Comprises the Second, Fourth and Twelfth wards of the City of San Francisco.

*Twelfth District.*—Comprises the Seventh, Ninth, Tenth and Eleventh wards of the City of San Francisco.

*Fifteenth District.*—Comprises the First and Third wards of the City of San Francisco and the County of Contra Costa.

*Nineteenth District.*—Comprises the Sixth and Eighth wards of the City of San Francisco.

### CITY AND COUNTY.

**FIRST WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by the waters of the Bay on the north and east, Washington Street on the south, and Battery Street on the west, including the islands in the Bay.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by the waters of the Bay on the north, by the waters of the Bay and Battery Street on the east, Vallejo Street on the south and Kearny Street on the west.

*Third Precinct.*—Bounded by Vallejo Street on the north, Battery Street on the east, Washington Street on the south and Kearny Street on the west.

**SECOND WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by the waters of the Bay on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Vallejo Street from Kearny to Stockton Street on the south, Stockton Street from Vallejo to Filbert Street on the west, Filbert Street from Stockton to Taylor Street on the south and Taylor Street on the west.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by the waters of the Bay on the north, Taylor Street from the waters of the Bay to Filbert Street on the east, Filbert Street from Taylor to Stockton Street on the north, Stockton Street from Filbert to Vallejo Street on the east, Vallejo Street from Stockton to Larkin Street on the south and Larkin Street on the west.

**THIRD WARD.**—Bounded by Washington Street on the north, Market Street and the waters of the Bay on the east, California Street on the south and Kearny Street on the west.

**FOURTH WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by Vallejo Street on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Washington Street on the south and Mason Street on the west.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by Vallejo Street on the north, Mason Street on the east, Washington Street on the south and Larkin Street on the west.

**FIFTH WARD.**—Bounded by California Street on the north, Market Street on the east and south and Kearny Street on the west.

**SIXTH WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by Washington Street on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Sacramento Street on the south and Larkin Street on the west.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by Sacramento Street on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Pine Street on the south and Larkin Street on the west.

**SEVENTH WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by Market Street on the northwest, Fremont Street on the northeast, Natoma Street on the southeast and Second Street on the southwest.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by Natoma Street on the northwest, Fremont Street on the northeast, Harrison Street on the southeast and Second Street on the southwest.

*Third Precinct.*—Bounded by Market Street on the northwest, by the waters of the Bay on the east, Harrison Street on the southeast and Fremont Street on the southwest.

**EIGHTH WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by Pine Street on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Post Street on the south and Mason Street on the west.

*Second Precinct.*—Bounded by Post Street on the north, Kearny Street on the east, Market Street on the southeast and Mason Street on the west.

*Third Precinct.*—Bounded by Pine Street on the north, Mason Street on the east, Geary Street on the south and Larkin Street on the west.

*Fourth Precinct.*—Bounded by Geary Street on the north, Mason Street on the east, Market Street on the southeast and Larkin Street on the west.

**NINTH WARD—First Precinct.**—Bounded by Har-
