BOARD OF SUPERVISORS.

Term of office two years (1880, one year); salary \$1,200 per annum; terms expire first Monday in January, 1881. Weekly meetings each Monday evening. Quarterly meetings first Monday in January, April, July, and October. Special meetings at the discretion of the President.
