Every worthy officer, soldier, sailor, or marine, who is a bona fide resident of the State and who honorably served in the Army or Navy of the United States in any war in which the country has been engaged, and who is in indigent circumstances, and by reason of age, infirmity, or wounds received in service, is incapable of self-support, shall be entitled to admission into the Home, subject to the laws of the State of California and to the regulations prescribed by the Board of Directors for its control and management.
