The Pacific-Union Club is a consolidation of the Pacific and Union Clubs, two social organizations that existed in San Francisco; the former since the year 1852, and the latter since 1854. The Pacific-Union Club was incorporated in March, 1881, and the consolidation took place in February, 1889.

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
