

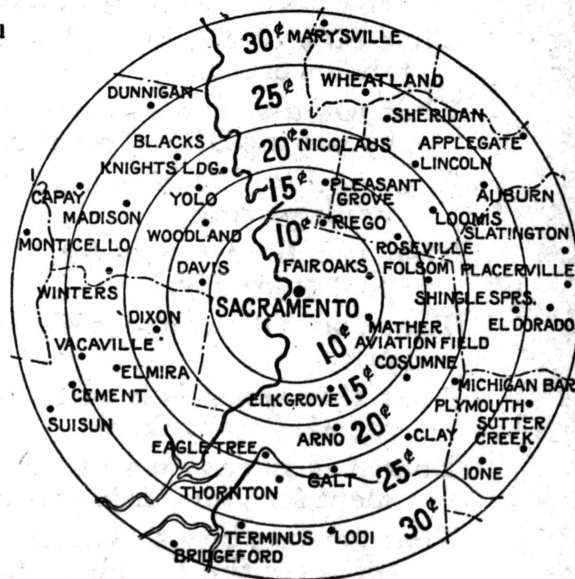
Over the Voice Highways!
