

Rates to Certain Pacific Coast Points (Continued)

Table with columns for TO, STATION-TO-STATION, PERSON-TO-PERSON, and FROM PLACERVILLE, FROM ROSEVILLE, FROM SUISUN-FAIRFIELD, and FROM WOODLAND. It lists various destinations and their corresponding rates.

† Day rates are in effect from 4:30 A.M. to 7:00 P.M., except Sunday; Night rates from 7:00 P.M. to 4:30 A.M.; Sunday rates, all day Sunday.

The time prevailing at the calling point when connection is established governs the application of Night and Sunday rates.

* On a Station-to-Station call to this point, give number to local operator.

Station-to-Station rates of 25¢ or less are for an initial period of 5 minutes. All Station-to-Station rates in excess of 25¢, and all Person-to-Person rates are for an initial period of 3 minutes.

Rates to points not listed above may be obtained by calling "Long Distance."

A limited charge, known as a "Report Charge," is made on uncompleted Person-to-Person, Appointment, Messenger, Collect and Conference calls if the called telephone is reached but communication between the calling and called parties is not established for reasons beyond the control of the Telephone Company.

The Federal Tax is not included in the above rates.

Federal Tax. There is no Federal Tax on telephone calls for which the total charge is under 50 cents. The tax is 10 cents if the charge is 50 cents and less than \$1.00; it is 15 cents if the charge is \$1.00 and less than \$2.00; and 20 cents if \$2.00 or more.
