

HOW TO MAKE LONG DISTANCE CALLS

Station-to-Station Calls—(When you will talk to anyone)

Dial Direct as shown on pages 2 and 3.

Dial Operator for other calls.

From pay phones, dial Operator.

To get telephone number, dial Operator and ask for information at the place you want to call.

Person-to-Person Calls—

Dial Operator. Give her the city, telephone number (or name and address) and what person, department or extension you want.

Collect Calls—Dial Operator and tell her when you place the call—not afterward—that you want it made "collect".

Calls to Alaska and Hawaii—Dial Operator.

Calls to Overseas Points—Dial Operator and ask for Overseas Operator for the country you are calling.

Calls to Ships and Planes—Dial Operator and ask for Marine Operator.

Calls to Autos, Trucks and Trains—Dial Operator and ask for Mobile Service Operator.

Upon request, the Operator will notify you at the end of a stated period of time on long distance calls.

TYPICAL LONG DISTANCE RATES

Here are some examples of station-to-station rates to out-of-town points. The rates shown are for three minutes and do not include Federal Tax. Person-to-person calls cost more than station-to-station calls. A collect call, to be billed to the number you are calling, costs no more than other calls except that the minimum charge is 30c. Night and Sunday rates for station-to-station calls apply from 6:00 P.M. to 4:30 A.M. and all day Sunday.
