

GENERAL INFORMATION

NON-SUBSCRIBERS.—When it is desired to have a non-subscriber call one of our public offices at a distant place, a messenger will be sent for at the expense of the party ordering service.

LONG DISTANCE CALLS.—To make connection with other towns, remove hand telephone from the hook and when operator asks "Number please," say "Long Distance." When the Long Distance operator answers "This is Long Distance" give your telephone number and name and the town, telephone number and name of the party wanted. *The operator will make no charge for calling "Long Distance."* (See page XV for Two-Number Toll Service.)

MOVES.—Seven days written notice is required in all cases where the location of a telephone is to be changed. Please fill out "Move Order" on page XVI of this book and mail same to the Company.

TELEPHONE NUMBER.—We advise the use of the expression "Telephone Connection" on stationery, wagons, and in advertising, as we may be forced to change your number to meet service requirements.

TELEGRAMS.—Arrangements have been made with the Western Union Telegraph Company under which subscribers of this Company may transmit by telephone to Western Union offices telegrams and cablegrams destined to any part of the world, but this Company does not assume any responsibility for failure to transmit, or for errors in transmission or delivery. To expedite the service, a subscriber desiring to transmit a telegram or cablegram, may call "Telegram" and, unless otherwise directed, the operator will connect him with a receiving station of the Western Union Telegraph Company.

The tolls for the telegrams and cablegrams so transmitted will be charged to the subscriber.

To facilitate the delivery of telegrams, the Western Union Company, when desired, will deliver messages to telephone subscribers by telephone instead of by messenger. The sender of the telegram may indicate that he desires such delivery by omitting the street address and substituting therefor the telephone number of the subscriber addressed.

The Pacific Telephone and Telegraph Company will also continue to send telegrams over its system as heretofore.
