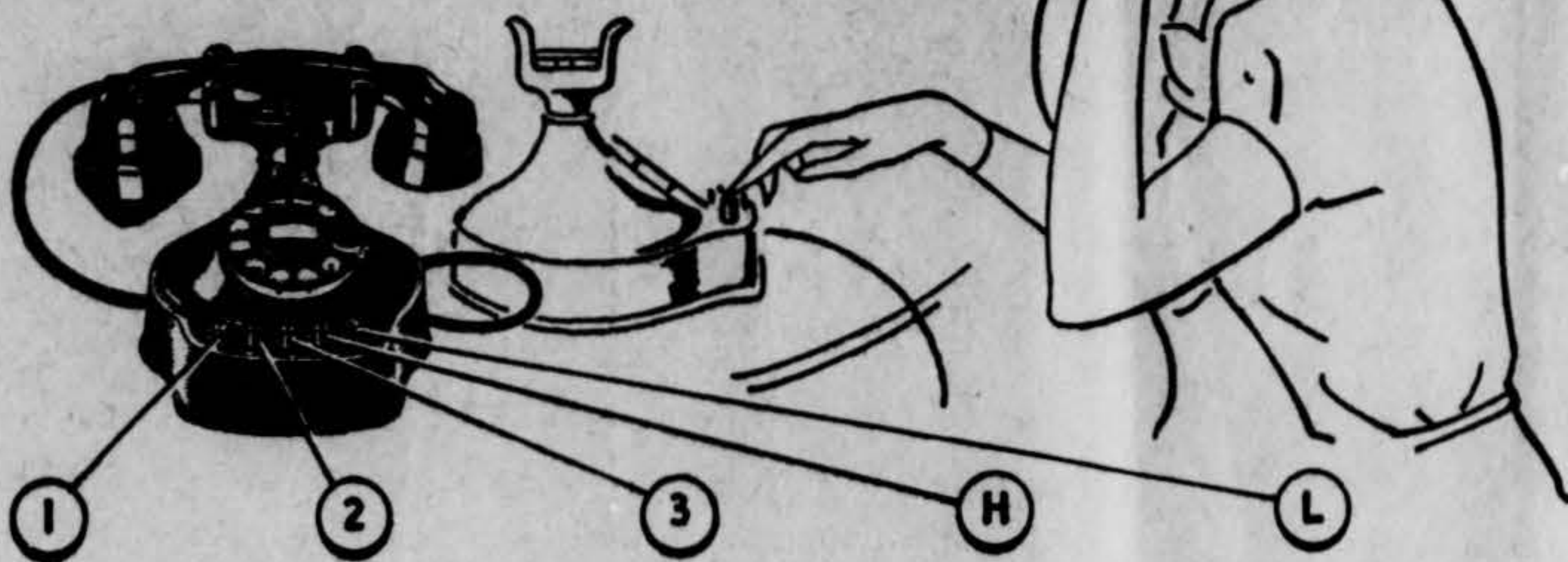


KEY HANDSET EQUIPMENT FOR HOMES AND OFFICES

A telephone and switchboard combined in one piece of equipment at each location provides intercommunication and outside service.



1 Connects the telephone with any one of three outside lines to make or receive a call. By merely depressing one of these keys, calls may be placed and received via the corresponding outside line.

H Holds a call while making or receiving a call on another line or intercommunicating.

L Connects the telephone with inside line to make or receive an intercommunicating call.

TELEPHONE EQUIPMENT TO MEET SPECIAL SERVICE NEEDS



HANG-UP TYPE HAND TELEPHONE

This type of instrument is designed for use where space on table or desk top is not available. For example, in the kitchen, breakfast room, or den where it will be out of the way, yet quickly available.

PORTABLE TELEPHONES

These extension telephones can be "plugged in" when required in guest rooms or other occasionally used places, or at night when a bedside telephone is desired.



AMPLIFIER TO IMPROVE HEARING

An amplifier can be attached to your telephone. It has several stages of amplification and enables most persons with impaired hearing to enjoy the use of a telephone. Special bell or light signals also are available.



KEY BOXES TO INCREASE THE USEFULNESS OF YOUR TELEPHONE

This is one of several devices that have intercommunicating, holding, pick-up and privacy features. It can be mounted inconspicuously on the side of desk or table, or on the wall within convenient reach. The keys are easy to operate and they give finger-tip control of telephone communication system of the home or office.
