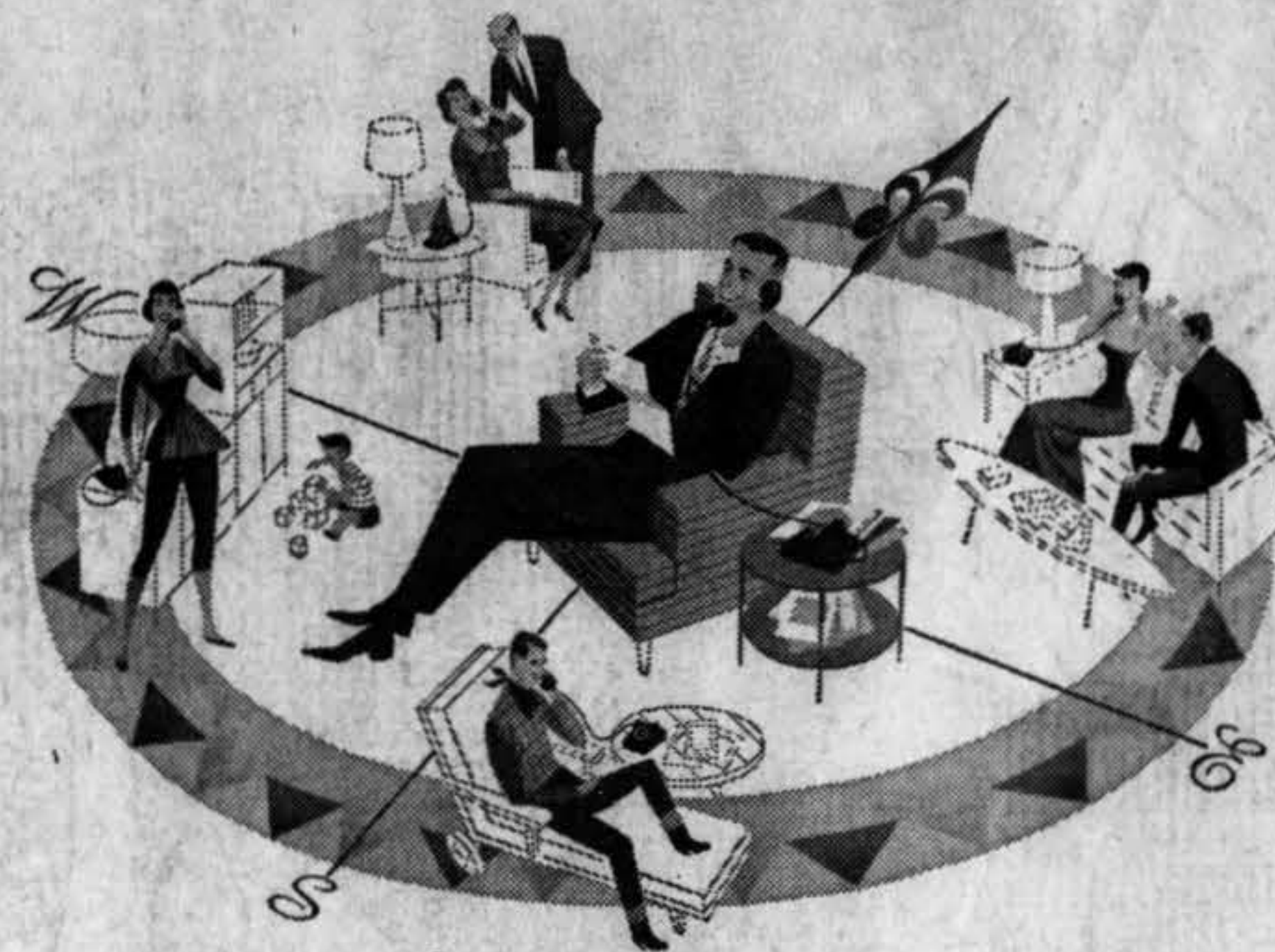
Share a party line?

These easy pointers can help you and your party line neighbor enjoy even better telephone service: When you have a series of calls to make, allow a few minutes between them • Replace the receiver properly after calling • If you have a dial telephone, make sure the line is not in use before you dial • Ask the children to be considerate, too.
