

## LONG DISTANCE RATES

These typical rates are for the first 3 minutes and do not include the Federal Excise Tax. Most rates are lower every night and all day Saturday, Sunday, Thanksgiving, Christmas and New Year's Day. Time at the calling point governs the application of these rates. For rates to other points, dial the Long Distance Operator. The minimum charge for a collect call within California is 30c.

### EMPLOYEE IDENTIFICATION

For your protection, all telephone people who visit your home or office carry a Pacific Telephone identification card showing their name, photograph, signature and physical description.

### "BEEP" TONE

Occasionally people need to record telephone conversation for business or other reasons. When this is being done, you will hear a beep tone every 15 seconds to let you know that your conversation is being recorded. This signal is legally required to protect you.

### OUT-OF-TOWN DIRECTORIES

If your telephone service needs require that you frequently use a directory for a city, or calling area, other than your own, out-of-town directories are available through our business office. Some may be had without additional cost. Others may be obtained for a reasonable charge. For information, just call our business office.

### TARIFFS

Tariffs which show rates and rules for telephone service and facilities, which are on file with the California Public Utilities Commission, are available in our Business Office for public inspection. In addition, leaflets covering basic rates for service are available upon request.

### ATTACHMENTS

The telephone company furnishes all equipment necessary to provide telephone service. In the interests of safety and good service, no equipment, apparatus or device not furnished by the telephone company may be attached to, or used, or connected to its facilities except as otherwise provided in the company's tariffs.

## TYPES OF CALLS

### STATION-TO-STATION CALLS

Call station-to-station if you'll talk with anyone who answers. You can dial many of these calls direct (see pages 11-15). Rates are lower than person-to-person and charging begins when the called telephone is answered.

### PERSON-TO-PERSON CALLS

Call person-to-person when you wish to talk to a particular person or extension phone. Tell the "OPERATOR" you wish to make a "person-to-person" call. Rates are higher than station-to-station calls. Charging starts when conversation begins with the person you've called.

### COLLECT CALLS

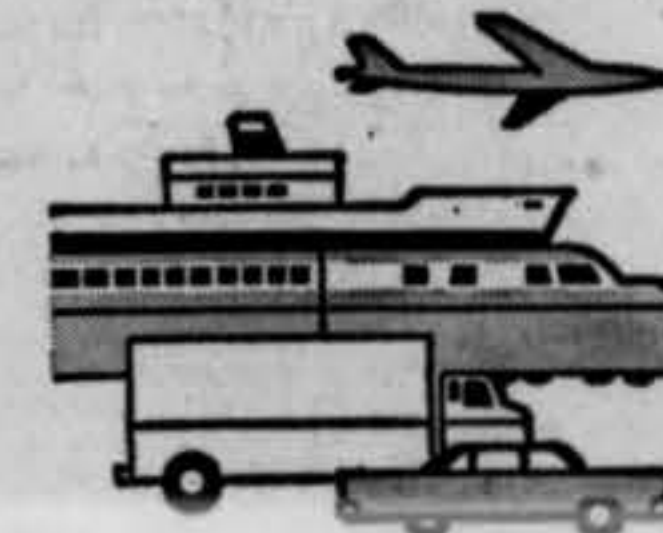
You can call "collect" if the person or firm you are calling agrees to pay the charge. If you want to make a "collect" call, please be sure to tell the "OPERATOR" when you place the call.

Upon request the Operator will notify you at the end of a stated period of time on Long Distance calls.



### CONFERENCE CALLS

You can talk with several people in different places at the same time. Dial the "OPERATOR" and tell her you wish to make a conference call.



### MOBILE AND MARINE SERVICE

You can make Local and Long Distance calls to automobiles, trucks, trains, aircraft and boats equipped for telephone service. Dial Operator and ask for the Mobile Service Operator, or the Marine Operator.



### OVERSEAS CALLS

Calls to practically all the world's telephones can be made from your telephone. Tell the Operator you wish to place an overseas call and give her the name of the country you are calling.
