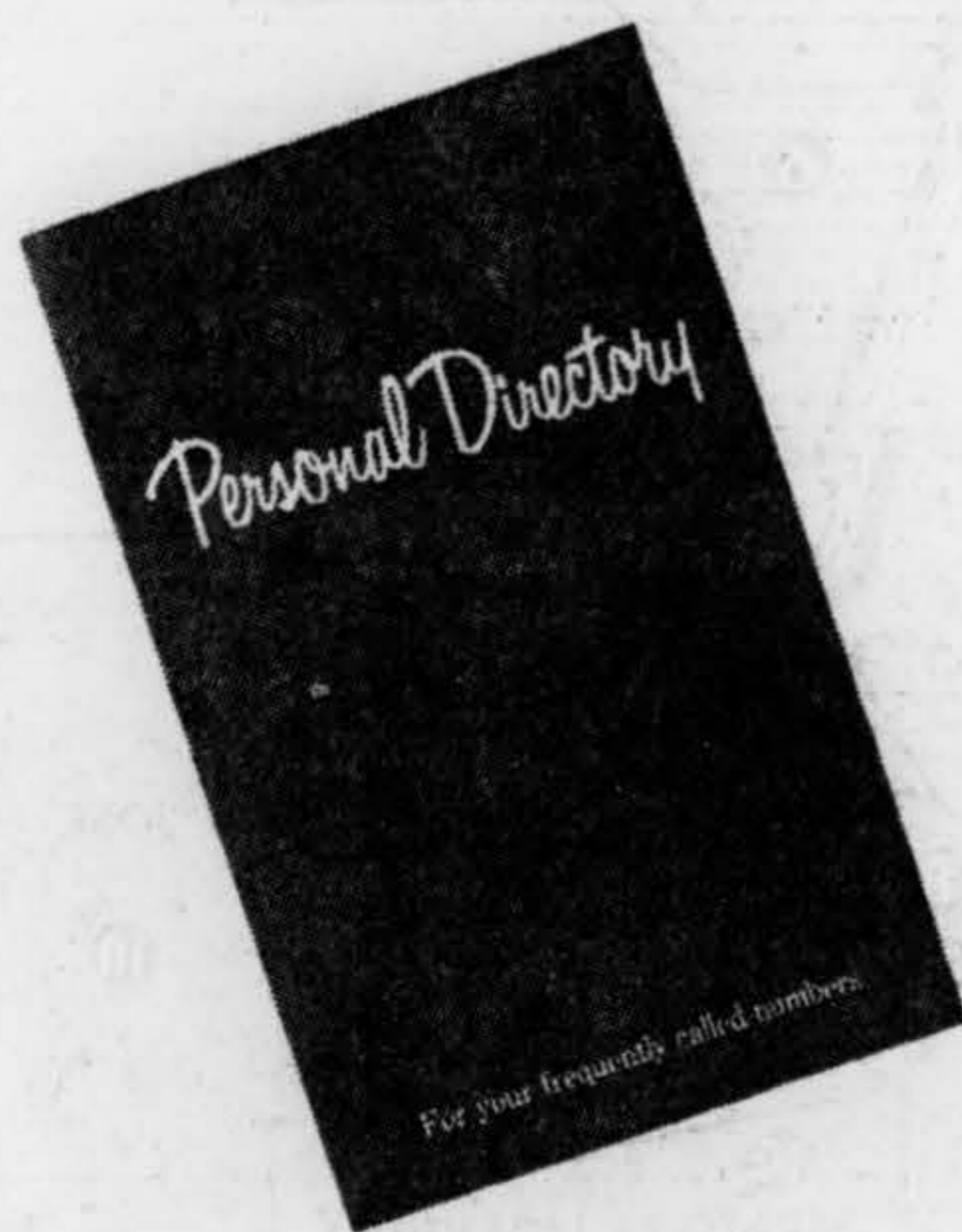

EMERGENCY CALLS

For emergency calls, telephone numbers of your local service area and other important matters, use your local Telephone Directory.

WARNING:

California Penal Code Section 384 makes it a misdemeanor for any person who shall willfully refuse to immediately relinquish a telephone party-line when informed that such line is needed for an emergency call to a fire department or police department or for medical aid or ambulance service. Also, any person who shall secure the use of a telephone party-line by falsely stating that such line is needed for an emergency call, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor. "Emergency" means "a situation in which property or human life is in jeopardy and the prompt summoning of aid is essential."
