The Bucs opened the '77 season with back-to-back shutout victories over McAteer and Washington. The O'Connell Boilermakers proved a stumbling block for Bal, beating them 2-1. The Bucs then put 21 goals in the net to register victories over Lowell, Lincoln, Galileo, and a hard-fought 2-2 draw with Mission. Wilson surprised the Balboa eleven by beating them 2-0 on the last day of the season, the only game Bal failed to score in all year.

The playoffs saw O'Connell and Balboa play to a 2-2 tie during regulation time and 4 "sudden victory" overtime periods. The bucs scored 3 goals in the penalty kick shoot-out to win the game. Scoring for Bal were David Torres, Mike Graham and Don Cusack. David Torres also provided the defense in the goal during the shoot-out. The Bucs played in the championship game for the 3rd straight year. The Mission Bears exploded for 7 goals to defeat the former city champs.

Coach Nevius reflects back on the bright spots of the '77 season: 1. The team led the league in scoring with 30 goals for the 3rd straight year. 2. The team had 11 different players score goals. 3. The defense had the 2nd best record in the city. 4. 8 players were selected to the All-City team. 5. Seniors leave with a record of 18 wins, 5 losses and 2 ties in 3 years, and played in 3 championship games.

She has done a fantastic job for fifty years — but in the later years, some of the enthusiasm has been lost. But before you blame her, you must remember she is old but she hasn't given up. Just remember those Move-Up Assemblies; all the new Seniors are so excited and happy. Ever wonder where they got their enthusiasm from? Well, all that excitement of the past put together with her special touch reaches inside of them, and then they too learn the meaning of the word "Togetherness". Remembering how I left Balboa, I can honestly say that I am not only one who left with more than a diploma.

So I congratulate Balboa for her determined will and I know she will continue through the years. I thank the faculty who have kept Balboa together, and most of all, I thank each and every student who graduated from 1931 to 1978 because they will remember Balboa as she will always be — "FIRST ON THE PACIFIC."






DIFFERENT DAYS — DIFFERENT WAYS

It would be tedious and perhaps not worth the space to enumerate all the trials and errors through which we passed in our ten months of planning for this Golden Anniversary edition of the **GALLEON**. Many seemingly reasonable assumptions proved false, countless hopeful leads brought us to dead ends, more than a few promises were accepted but not kept. The sweetest moments of the year were when our faith was rewarded, the bets paid off, and a few winners emerged who looked last Fall like dark horses indeed. In keeping with a grand tradition at Balboa, a number of recent graduates lent a welcome and willing hand. Later, we appealed to the Alumni Association and were bountifully provided with encouragement and assistance.

We plunged first into the past volumes of the **GALLEON**, and quickly found that nowhere could a complete set be found. Some of the gaps were filled through the courtesy of the school library, the Teachers' Professional Library, and the rest were lent to us by individuals. Starting with a 56-page paper-bound volume called "The Balboa Journal" produced by Miss Hazel M. FISHER, the Vice-Principal, from such a modest beginning in Spring, 1929, we have discovered over the years large and lavish productions with full-color aplenty and a scope which is no longer possible. A major handicap was a lack of consistency in the numbering of volumes. What at first seemed to be a special kind of magazine turned out to be the Fall, 1947 equivalent of a yearbook. Christened "The Treasure Chest", it was the outcome of the Principal's decision that the student body did not care to support a full-scale yearbook any longer. Fortunately, that event shocked the Buccaneers so much that the book has continued to appear regularly since then with variations only in physical size and content. For the last two decades, most volumes have appeared with a Supplement, the printing industry's answer to delivering a yearbook before Graduation when the last pages must be sent in before Easter Vacation.

Over the forty-seven years since we discovered the value of a yearbook, there have been a number of advisors, and good things might well be said about their ingenuity and perseverance. For sheer endurance and fertile imagination for over twenty years, Miss Jenness L. HUDSON deserves the highest respect and admiration. We have tried to cull the wheat from the chaff, and warmly thank those who recorded our traditions so faithfully.


